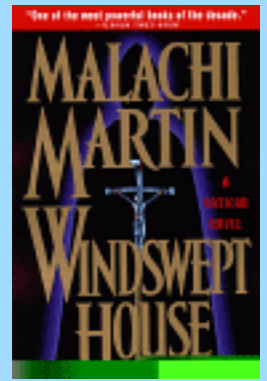

Tom, interesting that the word "chaplain" and "servicemen" would come up, within the context of the interview. I recall, in that recent C2C broadcast/interview conducted by Ian Punnet(sp?) a couple of weeks go (Messenger from God?), the guest/author doubted that Fr. Malachi had been a chaplain for servicemen. Further, I believe 2 callers indicated that Fr. Malachi had made references (in a letter to callers) to being a chaplain for servicemen in Turkey. The author was rather hasty in casting doubt at this caller's statement. I seem to recall that Fr. Malachi was assigned to Turkey/Anatolia region, to conduct research. The time period was presumably after 1954. I felt the author should have done more research on this issue.

Frankly, I found your research and familiarity with a number of facts and issues (having listened to many Fr. Martin interviews conducted by Art Bell and others) to be superior, and with a greater depth of analysis. I know I am a tough critic, but the Punnet guest/author seemed to be on unfamiliar territory.

Although the author conducted interviews with colleagues, friends and family; and transcribed interviews conducted by his father, there seemed to be voids in his research. I am more impressed with your work, and your willingness to read and evaluate a number of sources.



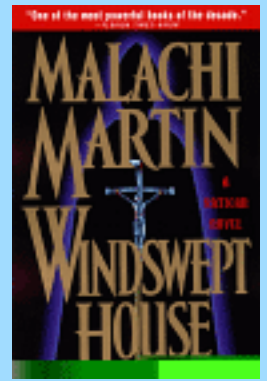

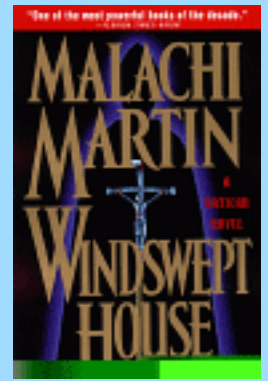

My FMS is fairly severe as I have pushed my body a lot when I was growing. I am exhausted and rarely get a good nights sleep. I have arthritis in all my major joints.

I also have EDS which is a syndrome in which my collagen isn't made correctly. That is really tough on all my joints, and leads to severe bleeding episodes for me as well...somedays it is just too hard to even use my fingers on the keyboard.

Of course, it doesn't help that while I was still in my teens I was forcing a lot of weight on my joints. I'm fine framed and we didn't know I had weak joints so I was landing triple lutzers with very little warm-up. Imagine going backwards in a circle. Stop hard with your toe forcing you to start turning in the opposite direction -in the air-and landing on that toe. That was my favorite jump :-P Plus I did a lot of pointe work-about an hour a day 6 days a week. Now at 31 I am paying for it big time....and if I do the wrong thing on the wrong day I still get a bad bleed...which can take weeks to stop in a joint causing more arthritis.

Sorry for going on like this....I love it here in Southern CA. I hope you enjoy it as well. I live near the ocean...I wouldn't trade it for the world.
