Rev. 9: 1, 5th. Angel sounded.


THE ROMAN OR 4th EMPIRE

It continued for an hour, and a day, a month, and a year. 391 years, and 15 days, which ended August 11th 1849.




Rev. 9: 13. 6th. Angel, 2^d woe.

Rev. 10: 7. In the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall BEGIV to sound, the MYSTERY of God shall be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

Rev. 11: 15-19. And the seventh angel sounded, and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become of our Lord, and of his Christ, and he shall reign for ever and ever.
